



FERTILIZER RECOMMENDATIONS

PLANT	FERTILIZER	WHEN	AMOUNT	METHOD OF APPLICATION
CONIFEROUS EVERGREENS	10-10-10 or Acid Green	Mid-late May	3 oz/foot of height	Broadcast evenly under dripline of foliage
BROAD-LEAVEDS EVERGREENS	Cottonseed Meal Compost topdress	Mid-late May	1-3 cups/plant 1-2" compost	Broadcast evenly under shrub, out to its dripline
DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTALS & VINES	10-10-10 Compost topdress	Mid May & Late June	3 oz/ foot of height 1-2" compost	Broadcast evenly under shrub, out to its dripline
FRUIT & NUT TREES	10-10-10 Compost topdress	Mid-late May	3 oz/foot of height 1-2" compost	Broadcast evenly under shrub, out to its dripline
BERRY BUSHES	10-10-10 Compost topdress	Mid-late May	½-1 oz./sq. ft. 1-2" compost	Broadcast evenly under shrub, out to its dripline
ROSES	Rose food 10-10-10 Compost topdress	Mid-May & Late June	½-1 oz./sq. ft. 1-3" compost	Broadcast evenly under shrub, out to its dripline
HERBACEOUS PERENNIALS & GROUNDCOVERS	10-10-10 or 5-10-10 Compost topdress	Mid-May	½-1 oz./sq. ft. 1-2" compost	Broadcast evenly away from crown
ANNUALS & BEDDING PLANTS	10-10-10 & compost Osmocote	Well before planting After planting	½-1 oz./sq. ft. ½-1 oz./sq. ft	Incorporate 6-8" into soil Topdress after planting
SPRING FLOWERING BULBS	Bulb food or 10-10-10	Early spring, just as tops appear	½-1 oz./sq. ft.	Broadcast evenly
LAWN	10-6-4 or 10-10-10	May, July & October	15-20 lb./1000 sq. ft.	Broadcast evenly

NOTE: Fertilizer does not release without proper irrigation (1" of rain or water per week).
